any stables.**



STABLING

A limited number of stables are available for competitors. Stables will be available from Wednesday 21st – Sunday 25th August inclusive.

Stabling options for 2019

- Wednesday duration stable
Price: £160 (including VAT)
Boxes will be available from 4pm on Wednesday 21st August until Sunday 25th August.
- Thursday duration stable
Price: £140 (including VAT)
Boxes will be available from 4pm on Thursday 22nd August until Sunday 25th August.
- Single night stable
Price: £60 (including VAT) per night
Wednesday night, Thursday night, Friday night or Saturday night.
If the stable is booked for one night only it will be available from 4pm on the day booked and **MUST BE vacated and mucked out by 2pm the following day.**

All stables need to be booked via Equo Events (www.equoevents.co.uk), no stabling bookings will be accepted by phone or email. Stabling will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Applications open on the 1st June 2019. **Bookings close 8th August 2019, or when all stables are filled.** Strictly NO applications will be accepted after this date.

No refunds will be given for stabling cancelled after the closing date. Stabling applications will NOT be accepted without payment.

Please contact the horse trials office if you need to resell your stable.

Straw is supplied for bedding; competitors requiring shavings are welcome to bring their own or purchase them at the event. Hay is not supplied.

Stabling will be accepted with valid entry to one of the Land Rover Blair Castle Horse Trials satellite competitions.

Please ensure that **the correct postal address is in the system of Equo Events prior booking**, as we will send the pack of passes and wristbands to that address.

Please keep informed the Horse Trials Office prior the event and the stable manager during the event if there are any changes of the owner of your stable. We need at least one appropriate contact with a mobile phone number in case of emergency.

DATA PROTECTION INFORMATION

By entering any class through EquoEvents, you agree to the following:

- To allow the data provided on the entry form being processed and stored electronically for the purposes of managing your competition entry and to its being shared with third party organizations for verification of qualifying status and results etc. e.g. for affiliated or related championships and finals.
- For the owners/exhibitors name and horse details to be displayed in the official catalogue, and to be released to appropriate third parties.

CAMPING

Only competitors who have booked stables are permitted to stay overnight in their horseboxes. Competitors who have not booked stabling must leave the showground at the end of the show day. Horses and ponies may not be kept in horseboxes overnight. Pens are not permitted overnight or during the day. Anyone erecting pens will be asked to take them down.

There is limited competitor camping permitted in the Lorry Park. Each booking comes with ONE vehicle pass for your horsebox or car and trailer. Any vehicles without the correct pass will be redirected to Car Park 1, where they will be required to purchase parking.

For those who have booked stabling for the night prior to their competition day, access to the site will be possible from 4pm the day before your competition.

ALL EXHIBITORS/RIDERS/OWNERS are requested to obey the instructions to enter and leave the site and to respect the direction given for horsebox parking by the officials in charge of this area. According to the Fire Services' instructions, if you are sleeping in your trailer/lorry, there must be a 4m gap in each direction from your trailer/horsebox. It is not permitted to erect a tent in the lorry parking. Please note there is no electrical hook-up in the lorry park.

GENERAL

The Organisers of the Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials reserve the right to eliminate competitors if in the opinion of an event official or vet a rider is an inappropriate weight for the horse or pony. This includes riding in the collecting rings and exercise areas.

CURFEW

There is a curfew on riding of 7pm throughout the event. This includes warm up arenas and hacking as well as competition arenas. Horses and ponies may still be exercised in hand or lunged after this time. Anyone found riding after curfew may be asked to leave the venue. No refunds will be given for stabling or entry fees.

ADMISSION

Wristbands and passes will be issued according to the entries and stabling booking.

Competitors will be issued 2 Wrist Bands for the first entered horse and 1 Wrist Band for each additional horse thereafter, one additional wristband for each rider under the age of 16 years.

All further admission passes must be purchased via the box office at www.blairhorsetrials.co.uk/box-office

1 Vehicle pass will be issued per one or two entered horses. Additional cars must park in the public car park.

DISEASE

Any animal found suffering from a contagious or infectious disease is to be removed from the Showground immediately at the request of the Veterinary Surgeon.

DOPE TEST

The Committee reserve the right to have any animal tested.

CONTROL

Any animal not under control **MUST** be removed from the showground immediately when so requested by an Official.

DOGS

Dogs are permitted on the Showground but **MUST** be on a lead at all times. Blair Castle Estate Ltd has requested that people are considerate and please pick up fouling left by their dogs. Free bags are available from either the Stable Manager's Office or from the main Information Marquee. Anyone found in violation of this will be required to donate £10 to the event's chosen charity or will be asked to leave the venue immediately. No refunds will be given.

HORSE WELFARE
